Dear Past, Present and Future Food Vendors,

The Fair Oaks Recreation and Park District (FORPD) has implemented changes that may affect your participation in upcoming 2015 events. The following changes have been implemented for various reasons including but not limited to: customer feedback, marketing, permits and decreased set up and clean up times.

**Fair Oaks Fiesta Days:** FORPD will accept applications from Food Vendors who hold a valid Mobile Food Facility (MFF) permit sticker at all times for the county where food is being sold (Sacramento). To obtain a permit, the vehicle must meet all requirements, submit a commissary verification form, complete an application, pay the annual permit fee, and pass an inspection with the Environment Management Department prior to turning in an application for the event. Proof of MFF certificate must be submitted with Application. Additionally, vendors in this category must be self sufficient, as there will be NO access to water or electricity.

**Kids Art Festival:** FORPD will no longer be accepting applications from for-profit Food Vendors or non-profit for this event.

**Fair Oaks Chicken Festival:** FORPD will no longer provide electricity or water for vendors. Vendors needing electricity will be required to provide their own whisper generators, and fuel for said generator. Vendor must list on application the type of generator that they will be using. Use of generator may assist in determination of booth location. FORPD will decide on location of generator, per fire department regulations. Vendor must supply at least 25 ft. of power cord. There will be NO access to water during set up or event hours. If water is needed vendor must supply own water.
